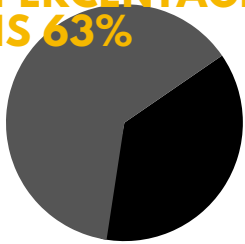


# MASS INCARCERATION IS A FAMILY ISSUE
